Biography

Councillor Bernie Robertson has lived in Charters Towers for the past 55 years during which time he and his wife, Megan, have raised their four children, owned businesses and been involved in many local community groups.

In 1965 Cr Robertson left Winton for Charters Towers to attend Mount Carmel College (1965-68) and has resided in the area ever since. Starting his career working for NORQEB (now Ergon) he went on to run his own electrical contracting business and operated Hollimans Hardware in a successful partnership for 21 years.

After selling the hardware business, Cr Robertson has and continues to work as a Rural Contractor and Rural Mail Delivery Contractor.

Cr Robertson has been involved in numerous local groups throughout the years including:
