NON ACCEPTABLE WASTE

- X Hazardous, flammable or combustible materials (e.g. empty drums and fuel tins)
- X Asbestos-Gas cylinders, fire extinguishers
- X Car parts and tyres
- 🗶 Liquid Waste, including paints and oils
- X Commercial and builder's waste
- × Glass and mirrors
- Other items that present a risk to safety.

PLEASE DO

- ✓ Place your rubbish in a pile outside your property so the footpath or roadway is kept clear
- ✓ Check the list of prohibited items collectors will leave all prohibited items behind
- ✓ Put your rubbish out just prior to the pre-arranged collection day
- Ensure items are secured if severe weather is expected
- ✓ Make sure items can be lifted by two people
