

Charters Towers Regional Council is facilitating a bulk rubbish collection in the township of **Hervey Range on Monday, 1 November 2021.**

IMPORTANT: How much can I place for collection? A limit of two (2) cubic metres will apply to ensure the provision of a financially sustainable service.

Items that will not be collected:

- Household Rubbish (e.g. food scraps)
- Vegetation and Green Waste
- Bricks and Concrete
- Hazardous, flammable or combustible material (e.g. empty drums and fuel tins)
- Asbestos
- Gas cylinders, fire extinguishers
- Car parts and tyres
- Liquid Waste, including paints and oils
- Commercial and builder's waste
- Glass and mirrors
- Other items that may present a risk to safety.

Examples of acceptable waste are:

- White Goods (fridges and freezers must have doors removed for safety)
- Mattresses (limit of 2 per property)
- Hot Water Systems
- Small household items (e.g. fans)
- Furniture
- Electronic Waste
- Toys, bicycles and sporting goods
- Tin and scrap iron up to 2 metres in length.
- Sinks
- Wood Products

PLEASE DO:

- ✓ Make sure items can be lifted by two people
- ✓ Ensure items are secured if severe weather is expected
- ✓ Put your rubbish out just prior to the pre-arranged collection day
- ✓ Check the list of prohibited items – collectors will leave all prohibited items behind
- ✓ Place your rubbish in a pile outside your property so the footpath or roadway is kept clear

PLEASE DON'T:

- ✗ Leave sharp or dangerous objects
- ✗ Leave rubbish out for long periods
- ✗ Leave your normal domestic rubbish (put it in your wheelie bin)
- ✗ Leave prohibited items out for collection – they will not be taken
