6.4 **Environment & Pests**

Discussion:

Roadside weeds

- Spraying activities limited by weather and poor access
- 4,000lts sprayed in Ravenswood, and concentrated on reserves such as Flatrock
- 20,000ltrs of herbicide sprayed so far this year

1080 Baiting program

- Beginning 28 April 2025
- Starting the program at Cardigan, followed by Silver Valley, Rangeview, etc.
- Access to baiting stations, consideration to move stations to other areas where access is questionable.

Calotrope and Prickly Acacia

- Dawsonvale Road enquiry
- Road inspectors and baiting crew spotting weeds across the region
- Encouraged to do a Customer Requests or Snap Send Solve
- Prioritisation and Risk determine spraying activities. Grader Grass and Bellyache bush are widespread, and activities will be limited to isolated pockets and protecting assets

Highway corridor responsibility

- RMPC (Road Maintenance Performance Contract) Council doing work through Main Roads
- Shared responsibility with annual limits on spending
- Requiring prioritising
- Some Highway sections Contracted out for slashing and poisoning activities

Grader Grass

- **Encouraged to Snap Send Solve or Customer Request**
- Around roadsides Dotswood Road, Eumara and Gainsford

7.0 **General Business**

Highway Mine

- Investigation of large crack in the ground
- Concerned it will cave in like Mt Leyshon
- Concerned proximity to edge of the pit

Action: Council to report to Main Roads (GP).

Causeways

- Funding to get back up and operating, raised with Andrew Cripps
- Operations developing a program to upgrade causeways
- \$3m funding secured, causeways identified by prioritisation

Coronation

- Bitumen peeling off with the water
- Encouraged to use Snap send solve

Action: Council to raise as a CR

Rural Land valuations

- Earning capacity hasn't increased
- 500% increase in four years
- Presentation by State Valuer to Council, informed the methodology hasn't changed, mainly going off recent sales
- Important to recognise that increase in valuation does not correlate to similar increase in rates as these are adjusted



- Modelling is currently being completed through an external consultant
- State Valuation appeal period (60 Days)
- Request for assistance in coordinating advocacy
- Andrew Cripps advocating strongly
- LGA RV has increased from \$18m rateable value to \$30m (66% Increase)
- 135% raise in Rural Agricultural

Betterment program consideration of:

- Campaspe approach on Helenslee Road
- Campaspe approach in Red Hill
- Support the Betterment Project

Unused stock routes and road access

Carbon accounting

- Carbon footprint reporting likely to increase red tape for producers in the coming years
