## RE: PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT ASSESSMENT

This assessment pertains to a proposed access easement from Weir Road for the purpose of gaining access to Lot 1 on MPH20321, Breddan.

Please accept the enclosed DA form 1 and proposed reconfiguration plan on behalf of the applicant, Ms. Jenny Brown.

We are seeking a development permit to create easements in the following manner:

Proposed Easement A in Lot 1 on MPH20321 at 8290 m2,

The current access to Lot 1 on MPH20321 is through Lot 1 on MPH21463 via a road that runs past the existing house. The purpose for the new easement is to create an excess that keeps it away from this house so as not to create any issues in the future.

Under the Charters Towers Planning Scheme, the proposed development requires assessment against the following codes:

- Reconfigure a Lot Code

- Development Works Code

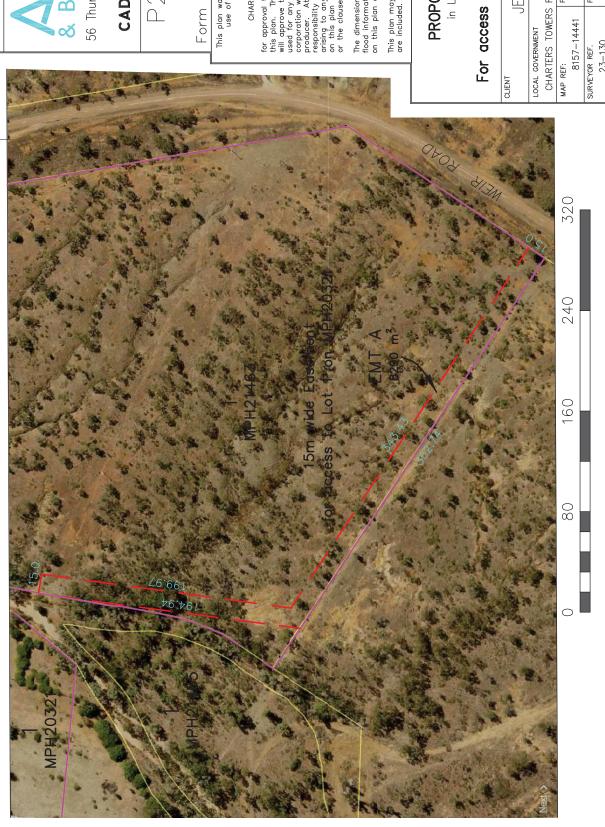
