Development Permit for Material Change of Use - Non-resident workforce accommodation

13 Church Street, Greenvale

This correspondence is made on behalf of UGL Pty Limited in relation to the abovementioned permit and the operational cease date (Sunset Clause) of the Material Change of Use permit for Non-resident workforce accommodation. In support of the application, please find enclosed Landowner's Consent.

Payment of \$350.00 will be made upon Council issuing the relevant tax invoice.

Recent Approval History

The subject site known as Greenvale Worker's Camp, originally received approval for a Material Change of use for Non-resident workforce accommodation (80 rooms) on 25 May 2023. The use commenced and is currently operating.

On 22 May 2024, Council issued a Changed Decision Notice approving a minor change. The changes agreed to as part of the minor change approval included:

- (1) Amending the timing of Condition 3 so that the use is ceased by 31 December 2024; and,
- (2) Amending the timing of Condition 4 to require buildings and structures to be removed from the site by 31 March 2025.

Further, on 25 July 2024, Council issued another Changed Decision Notice permitting an increase in the number of accommodation from 80 rooms to 128 rooms.

Project Status

The Greenvale Worker's Camp is relevant to the Genex Kidston Connect Project. Due to the unexpectedly longer wet season earlier this year there has been a delay in construction due to unsuitable construction conditions. As such, and in relation to the need for additional accommodation, construction is moving forward to finalise the project with more crews on the ground. However, despite the increase in crew and progress made to date,

further time is required to deliver the project and in turn, the accommodation facilities will be required for longer.

Change to Application

In accordance with **Section 78** of the *Planning Act 2016* we submit a request for a Minor Change to the Development Permit to have conditions modified as follows:

Condition 3: The use of Non-resident workforce accommodation must cease on or before 31 August 2025 unless otherwise agreed by the Council.

Condition 4: All buildings and structures must be removed and the site returned to predevelopment condition unless otherwise agreed by Council. Timing: By 30 November 2025

The request is made on the basis that the accommodation is now required to operate into 2025 to ensure completion of the project. It is anticipated that the accommodation requirement will end in mid-2025, but to provide some flexibility, it is requested that the Sunset Clause be extended to the end of August 2025, with the removal of related buildings and structures to be completed by the end of November 2025.

Please note there are no further changes required to any other Conditions nor the Approved Plans.

We trust this correspondence provides you with sufficient information in relation to the proposal and we look forward to receiving a positive decision from Council at your earliest convenience.
